



Town Center's 4th Annual Storybook Pumpkin Patch!

Dear Parents and Students,

Town Center is getting into the fall spirit by showing off your pumpkin creativity! All students are invited to decorate a pumpkin like your favorite book character. It's easy and fun (and voluntary – it's not homework!)

Students may bring a decorated pumpkin to the Media Center the week of **October 21st**. The pumpkins will be on display here until Friday, November 1. **All pumpkins will need to be picked up/sent home on November 1.**

Guidelines:

- Pumpkins may be painted, hot glued, colored, etc. **NO CARVED PUMPKINS.** Carved pumpkins rot quickly and attract bugs. Carved pumpkins will not be allowed. **(Plastic pumpkins are great to use!)**
- Pumpkins must represent a favorite book character. This is a home project and pumpkins should be decorated primarily by the student.
- Pumpkins may be dropped off at school or transported on the bus. If on the bus, the pumpkin must fit on the student's lap. Carrying the pumpkin in a bag is recommended.
- **Please fill out the attached form and send it in with your pumpkin.**
- If possible, each student should bring in the book which inspired their pumpkin to be put on display along with the pumpkin. Be sure to label the book with the student's name so it is sure to be returned.
- **Pumpkins must either be picked up by parents or taken home by students at the end of the day on November 1.** Any pumpkin remaining will be discarded.

I can't wait to see which books inspire you and what awesome character pumpkins you create! Our Media Center will look boo-tiful!
